2026 TENPIN SYDNEY EAST COAST TEAM ROLL OFFS TOURNAMENT PLAYING RULES

ELIGIBILITY: All Bowlers who are financial Adult / Junior Members of TBA Australia and bowling in a current or travelling league in a TBA registered centre are eligible to bowl in the 2026 Roll-off for the NSW East Coast Challenge Cup Teams and must bowl an All Events (Singles, Doubles & Triples - 9 games) entry in the Championships. Once selected team members must continue to bowl in a recognized league up to the end of 2026.

CODE OF ETHICS: Competitors must be capable of conducting themselves in such a manner so as not to reflect negatively or discredit on TBA, TENPIN SYDNEY and it's sub committees or the sport of Tenpin Bowling. The Tournament Director has the right to penalise bowlers for violations.

ENTERING AVERAGES: The entering average for a bowler will be their highest average achieved in any structured competition (where an average is kept for future competition) over eighteen (18) games or more as at 30th April 2026. Any pre bowled games are not valid until actually used, regardless of when they were bowled. e.g. a prebowls bowled before the end of May/July which is not used until after the end of May/July cannot count towards the game requirement at the end of May/July. Proof of average must be provided with the League Secretaries signature, this also includes any league which has finished after 1st June 2025 - April 2026. The East Coast Chairperson reserves the right to review the average and regrade any bowler prior to, or after the commencement of play.

All averages for Graded Bowlers bowling East Coast Roll-off will be verified prior to tournament start. Using an incorrect average may result in disqualification.

HANDICAPS: For all Graded Divisions will be 100% of 220.

RULES & REGULATIONS: All bowlers and Managers will be required to sign a "CODE OF CONDUCT" when teams are finalised. All other Rules & Regulations will be covered by ECCC committee, Tenpin Sydney and TBA. Any rule not covered will be decided by the ECCC committee.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES : No Ipods, mobile phones or any other electrical devices are allowed in the players area or on the lanes.

DRESS REGULATIONS: All bowlers must wear a full collared shirt or Bowling manufactured industry shirt.

Male: Trousers, dress jeans or dress shorts.

Female: Skirts, culottes, tailored slacks, dress jeans or dress shorts.

No head coverings shall be worn while bowling unless cultural requirements apply.

No other dress attire will be accepted.

Any individual exceptions to the dress codes must be sought and approved by the Tournament Director prior to bowling.

Selection FOR EAST COAST TEAMS

Top 7 qualifiers in the Open and Graded Adult and Graded Senior Divisions will form the ECCC Team for 2026.

Top 4 qualifiers in the Senior Open division will form the ECCC Team 2026

Top 6 Boys qualifiers and Top 6 Girls qualifiers in each Division will form the ECCC Team for 2026

A 1 (one) game roll off will be played in the event of a tie occurring for 7th place in the Adult and Graded Senior divisions, 4TH place in the Open Senior division and 6th place in U/21 divisions

Masters Qualification.

THERE WILL BE NO MASTERS ROLL OFF IN THIS YEAR'S CHAMPIONSHIP

The 2026 Master will be the bowler achieving the highest pinfall in each division over 17 games. (Open, Graded, Seniors & U/21).

A 1 (one) game roll off will be played in the event of a tie occurring for Master in all divisions.

Winners will receive a Masters Shirt and will represent Tenpin Sydney in the E.C.C.C Masters. (This will apply to all Divisions).

ALL ROLL-OFF GAMES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE

All TBA LEAGUE, TOURNAMENT and GENERAL PLAYING RULES apply during the Championships and Roll Offs

ENTRY FEES:

Adult/Senior Bowlers = \$450.00 total - Breakdown - \$150.00 Nomination Fee (Non Refundable) to accompany nomination form by 22/05/2026. Balance of \$300.00 to be paid in full prior to bowling your first Championships squad.

U/21 Bowlers = \$450.00 total - Breakdown - \$150.00 Nomination Fee (Non Refundable) to accompany nomination form by 22/05/2025. Balance of \$300.00 to be paid in full prior to bowling your first Championships squad.

Entire Entry Fee must be PAID IN FULL prior to bowling your first Championship squad.

Team Members: Each team member will receive 1 shirt, 3 entries into the Tenpin Australia Championships (Singles, Doubles, Teams) plus All events, plus 3 Masters entries, plus up to 16 games in the East Coast Challenge Cup.

Fees to be paid by bowlers when they have made the Team:- Include Extra Team shirts (approx. \$60.00), Compulsory Fund Raising (approx. \$60.00), Team photos (approx. \$15.00-\$30.00), Presentation Dinner ticket (approx. \$85.00)
