2026 TENPIN SYDNEY CHAMPIONSHIPS TOURNAMENT PLAYING RULES

ELIGIBILITY

The Tenpin Sydney Championships is open to all current financial Adult or Junior Members of TBA Australia in good standing. Membership will be verified. Participants must be a current resident of NSW or ACT and have resided in NSW or ACT in the last 6 months. Written application for special consideration will be reviewed and may be granted where current living conditions are affected due to education or work purposes.

CODE OF ETHICS

Competitors must be capable of conducting themselves in such a manner so as not to reflect negatively or discredit on TBA, TENPIN SYDNEY and its sub committees or the sport of Tenpin Bowling. The Tournament Director has the right to penalise bowlers for violations.

ENTERING AVERAGES

The entering average for a bowler will be their highest average achieved in any structured competition (where an average is kept for future competition) over eighteen (18) games or more as at 30th April 2026. If a bowler has no current 2026 average one will be set by the Tournament Committee. The Tournament Director reserves the right to review the average and regrade any bowler prior to, or after the commencement of play. Please note that proof of highest average is to be provided with each bowler's entry. Using an incorrect average may result in disqualification.

ENTRIES

Multiple entries from a bowler shall be permitted in Trios, Doubles and Singles. Entry fees must be paid with all entries. Please note that incomplete or incorrect entries will not be accepted.

A male and a female can bowl mixed in each category or discipline.

PRIZE FUNDS

All monies prescribed as "Prize Fund" will be paid out based on one (1) prize for every ten (10) entries, to a maximum of 3rd place. The winner (s) of each division will be the highest pinfall bowled in each event over three (3) games (scratch).

All prize money collected in an event will be returned to the participants in that event. If multiple entries are permitted, a bowler can be listed more than once in the prize list and receive the prize for any such position.

ALL-EVENTS

A bowler's first appearance in Trios, Doubles and Singles shall count towards All Events, regardless of the Division in which they are bowled.

For those bowler's rolling off for a Team, your first appearance in Trios, Doubles and Singles shall count towards your Championships component in the roll off.

SUBSTITUTES

A substitute shall not participate in All Events. Maximum substitutes Trios - 2, Doubles - 1. Substitutes can be used providing they do not change the Division from the original entry. Substitutes must be reported to the Tournament Director at least one (1) hour before the scheduled squad time.

TIES

In the case of a TIE in Trios, Doubles and Singles, the highest last game will determine final placing.

Lanes will be washed and oiled before the 9.00am squad and after 11.00am squad Saturday and Sunday.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES

No Ipods, mobile phones or any other electrical devices are allowed in the players area or on the lanes.

DRESS REGULATIONS

11 Hollylea Rd, Leumeah NSW 2560

Male: Trousers, dress jeans or dress shorts.

Female: Skirts, culottes, tailored slacks, dress jeans or dress shorts.

No head coverings shall be worn while bowling unless cultural requirements apply.

No other dress attire will be accepted.

Any individual exceptions to the dress codes must be sought and approved by the Tournament Director prior to bowling.

REFUNDS

No refunds will be made once entries are received.

CHECK-IN:

All bowlers must check-in prior to their squad times. Check-in closes 30mins prior to the scheduled squad start time.

ENTRIES CLOSING DATE

Championship entries will be accepted upto the closure of check-in providing lanes are available. Entries for Team Roll Offs will close last mail on 22nd May 2025.

THERE WILL BE NO MASTERS ROLL OFF IN THIS YEAR'S CHAMPIONSHIP

The Top Qualifiers for the NSW East Coast Challenge Cup Teams in each Division (Open, Graded, Seniors & U/21) will be declared the MASTERS CHAMPION.

Winners will receive a Masters Shirt and will represent Tenpin Sydney in the E.C.C Masters. *This will apply to all Divisions.*

All TBA LEAGUE, TOURNAMENT and GENERAL PLAYING RULES apply during the Championships

Protests affecting eligibility or general playing rules must be made in writing within thirty (30) minutes of the alleged offence with the tournament committee and before the tournament prize payments are made.

Acceptance of Rules of this Tournament and the TBA playing Rules is assumed with entry. No claim of ignorance will be accepted.

Any matters not covered in these conditions will be decided by the Tournament Directors whose decision will be final.
